Stuttgart – L'Actros L Driver Extent+ pousse l'idée d'un camion Mercedes-Benz haut de gamme encore plus loin et offre une expérience de conduite inoubliable. Cette nouvelle édition spéciale frappe par son design exclusif et son confort de « première classe ». Un rêve pour le conducteur, strictement limité à 150 unités. Mais qui ne sera pas disponible en France.

Le nom parle de lui-même : le logo Actros en chrome foncé de la proue offre une réelle élégance. Et le badge exclusif « Driver Extent+ » précise que ce camion est une édition spéciale limitée.

Le camion est doté de stickers exclusifs de couleur gris mat. De quoi ajouter des touches de couleur sous les vitres latérales ainsi que sur le pare-soleil, les garnitures latérales et l'avant. La couleur de la cabine peut être choisie librement. Le panneau avant noir rend la proue du véhicule plus expressive, tout comme l'étoile Mercedes-Benz illuminée et donc encore plus brillante.

Les quatre phares ronds de la rampe de toit améliorent aussi la visibilité du conducteur par tous les temps. Les phares dotés de la technologie LED économique en énergie ont été installés dans le pare-soleil. Les jantes avant et arrière sont équipées de cache-goujons de roue, de capuchons sur l'essieu arrière et de capuchons de protection des écrous de roue. Ceux-ci sont disponibles en peinture noire ou en acier inoxydable de haute qualité. Les protections de châssis en aluminium offrent deux marchepieds supplémentaires et complètent les marchepieds de série.

Le seuil de porte éclairé avec l'inscription Mercedes-Benz et les marches en acier inoxydable côtés conducteur et passager garantissent une entrée plus sûre et la plus en adéquation possible avec le caractère de ce modèle exclusif en édition spéciale.

Mais Driver Extent+ ne s'arrête pas à l'extérieur : l'éclairage d'ambiance avec un total de 138 LED assure une lumière agréable et indirecte dans la cabine et peut être réglé individuellement en couleur et en intensité.

La cafetière à dosettes est une autre particularité de ce camion. Elle s'intègre au design Mercedes-Benz et se range facilement dans le porte-gobelet grâce à sa taille pratique.

En outre, le dispositif antivol CabLock offre une protection accrue aux conducteurs. Le système peut être verrouillé et ouvert indépendamment du système de verrouillage central.
