Mercedes-Benz Special Trucks produira plus de 1 500 camions pour l'armée canadienne

Ottawa, Canada/ Leinfelden-Echterdingen – Mercedes-Benz Special Trucks produira plus de 1 500 Zetros dans le cadre d'une commande du ministère canadien de la Défense nationale. Les forces armées canadiennes prévoient d'utiliser ces véhicules pour le transport tout-terrain de marchandises et de personnel. Mercedes-Benz Special Trucks, Marshall Canada, l'entreprise française Soframe, Manac et General Dynamics Land Systems-Canada (GDLS-Canada) forment le consortium "The Power Team". Ces cinq entreprises collaborent à la mise en œuvre de la commande pour la modernisation de la flotte logistique canadienne dans le cadre du projet "Logistics Vehicle Modernization" (LVM).

Franziska Cusumano, Responsable de Mercedes-Benz Special Trucks, a déclaré : "Nous sommes ravis de travailler avec nos quatre solides partenaires pour équiper la flotte logistique canadienne. Ce contrat témoigne de la confiance que l'un des plus grands pays de l'OTAN accorde à notre réseau de partenaires, à notre expérience, à notre fiabilité et à nos compétences techniques. Ensemble, nous fournirons les bons produits et assurerons le meilleur soutien possible en service pendant de nombreuses années".

Les camions de la gamme Zetros serviront de châssis commun et seront produits dans l'usine Mercedes de Wörth-am-Rhein. Marshall Canada produira une gamme de modules de mission interchangeables de 10 et 20 pieds pouvant être montés sur ces Zetros. Manac fournira différentes remorques, tandis que le français Soframe est chargé du blindage des véhicules. General Dynamics Land Systems-Canada (GDLS-Canada) sera l'intégrateur principal de ce projet d'acquisition du ministère canadien de la Défense nationale. Au total, le Canada recevra plus de 1.000 Zetros légers (véhicules à deux essieux avec traction intégrale, 4x4) et environ 500 Zetros lourds (véhicules à quatre essieux avec traction intégrale, 8x8).

L'un des véhicules destinés au ministère canadien de la défense nationale, le nouveau Zetros 8x8 à quatre essieux et à transmission intégrale, est actuellement visible au salon Eurosatory, qui se tient à Paris jusqu'au 21 juin.
