City Transformer CT-2 is here. The innovative electric vehicle will make its debut during the days of the "Salone Auto Torino"

On Friday 13 September, in Turin, the revolutionary variable-track quadricycle will be officially presented with an event reserved for the press. Created in collaboration with the Turin-based CeComp, CT-2 aims to be produced in Piedmont and from here distributed to the main European markets

Turin, September 4th - City Transformer CT-2 is an innovative two-seater electric vehicle capable of changing its width to adapt to the various traffic conditions of our cities. Designed to become the ideal response to the needs of a new urban mobility, it will be presented on Friday 13 September during the opening day of the "Salone Auto Torino".

The debut of the CT-2 will take place at **12.30 pm** at the **NH Collection Piazza Carlina Hotel**, in Piazza Carlo Emanuele II, 15, during an event reserved for the press.

City Transformer CT-2 is 2.5 meters long, has a refined and distinctive design, a 450-liter load compartment and comfort and safety features worthy of a real car.

Thanks to the special chassis with variable track, it can change its width from 1.0 meters in the **City** configuration, designed to move easily even in the narrowest streets and park in the spaces reserved for motorcycles, to 1.3 meters in the **Performance** configuration, which guarantees greater stability at faster paces. In the first case CT-2 can reach a speed of 40 km/h; in the second the maximum speed reaches 90 km/h.

City Transformer CT-2 is a 100% electric vehicle powered by an LFP battery which guarantees a range up to 180 km. It will be available in a passenger version, with seats arranged in line, and in a commercial Cargo variant, single-seater and with a large rear compartment.

CT-2 represents the last step of the project born from the inventiveness of a group of Israeli engineers, designers and entrepreneurs who developed and patented a mobile track frame for a quadricycle. Evolution of the previous CT-1, which has already received numerous press and public acclaim, the CT-2 is now ready for large-volume production, which is intended to start in Piedmont.

The choice of the Italian region is not random: **CeComp**, one of the most important partner companies of City Transformer, which contributed to developing the vehicle and making it suitable for series

production, is based here. The commercial debut on the main European markets is set for the last

quarter of 2026.

To complete the initiative, City Transformer has started a dialogue with Ceipiemonte, Centro Estero

per l'Internazionalizzazione, a local investment and export agency, whose services are designed

specifically to attract foreign companies to the region. For this reason, on the morning of September

13th, a few hours before the event dedicated to the media, a meeting will be organized with companies,

institutions and potential investors.
