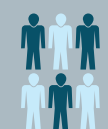


Ford of Europe

Ford of Europe is responsible for producing, selling and servicing Ford-brand vehicles in 50 markets. Headquartered in Cologne, Germany.



Employs 53,000 employees at its wholly-owned facilities and 68,000 people when joint ventures and unconsolidated businesses are included.



FoE operations include 24 manufacturing facilities (16 wholly-owned or consolidated joint venture facilities and 8 unconsolidated joint venture facilities).



In 2018, nearly 1,1 million vehicles were produced at Ford of Europe's wholly owned facilities and 416,000 at its joint ventures in Europe, totaling approximately 1,5 million vehicles.
