Defending champions in the overall Regularity category, **Étienne Bruet and Marc Jay** delivered a strong performance, finishing **8th overall**. This marks a solid result for their second participation as a team.

Notably, Marc Jay continues his streak of remarkable consistency, having completed all 13 editions he has entered!

In the **VHC category** (pre-1966 vehicles), the crew secured an impressive **5th place**, missing the podium by just a few seconds.

· Crew 2: Thomas Jay & Roland Salvi – Lancia Fulvia 1600 HF (1972)

At just **23 years old**, **Thomas Jay** continues to shine in the Tour Auto. Already the youngest category winner in history (2020) and overall winner in 2021 alongside his father Marc, Thomas achieved **2nd place** in the **H/I Regularity category** with experienced co-driver **Roland Salvi**—a remarkable result for their first collaboration.

They also claimed a commendable 9th place overall in the Regularity standings.

"Defending a title is never easy, but once again, the entire team—drivers, co-drivers, and support crew—rose to the challenge and delivered a strong performance," said Gaël Escribe, CEO of NEXUS Automotive International.
